

SolarApex v3.1a Upgrades

1. All User OSX shells have been changed to the tcshrc shell. A .tcshrc file has been placed in the /Users/<user> directory (<user> = ajones, setmgr, ajones). This should have no effect on existing software. Any changes to the shell environment (paths, classpaths, aliases, etc.) need to be made to the .tcshrc file. The older .cshrc or .bash_profile files have been left unchanged.
2. Xcode version 2.1 has been installed, which includes gcc 4.0 (gcc 3.9 is also available), Java 1.4, CHUD tools, and many others. “gcc somefile.c” should work at this point. The Xcode applications, tools, examples, etc. can be found under the /Developer root directory.
3. SolarApex version 3.0b is waiting for the first successful C code to be running before final delivery.

System Administration Note:

On SolarApex 1a, if it is necessary to make changes to a users shell environment, or make other OS X changes normally reserved for root privileges, there is a Mac OS X application that can be run from the MacMini GUI instead of the more traditional and cumbersome command-line commands: /Applications/Utilities/NetInfo Manager.app This will need to be run from the ajones, setmgr(recommended) or root accounts. Use this application with extreme caution: changes are permanent.
